WITH 593 LOTS, THE SUMMER SALE CATALOGUE IS NOW ONLINE

A mixed sale that brings together a number of different profiles, the Summer Sale is a proven source of Group/Graded winners in both disciplines. On the flat, the 2019 Queen Anne Stakes (Gr.1) hero LORD GLITTERS won the Jebel Hatta (Gr.1) at Meydan earlier this year. Over jumps, GREANETEEN took the Gr 1 Celebration Chase at Sandown and ABACADABRAS won the Gr 1 Aintree Hurdle, while CONCERTISTA added three Graded wins to her tally.

Created in 2016, the breeding section has already produced several top-level performers. Offered from Haras du Mezeray, WADYHATTA was carrying the future Queen's Vase (Gr.2) and Irish Derby (Gr.1) scorer SANTIAGO when bought by Horse France in July 2016. At the same sale, FULL OF BEAUTY was sold by Haras du Hoguenet to Carlos and Yann Lerner carrying the future Prix Edmond Blanc (Gr.3) winner WALLY.

The 2021 edition of the sale will take place from June 29-July 1 at Deauville, and will bring together **593 lots**. **Breezing on the All-Weather at Deauville-La Touques Racecourse on Tuesday, June 29 from 1pm**, a total of **81 flat-bred two-year-olds** will open the sale on **Wednesday, June 30 from 11am**. They will be followed by **156 two and three-year-old stores** and **23 three-year-olds in training from the Ecurie Centrale dispersion**. The Sale continues the day after at **10am** with the breeding section

made up of **127 fillies and mares** as well as **one stallion**, with a further **206 horses-in-training** closing the sale.

19 Wild Cards are still to come for recent performers on the Flat and over Jumps as well as for fillies and mares with attractive profiles. The Bloodstock team is at your disposal for more information.

Cessation of activity for Ecurie Centrale

The Summer Sale will host the first part of a dispersal from Ecurie Centrale, whose colours have been carried at the highest level, notably by dual Gr.1 Grand Steeple-Chase de Paris winner PRINCESSE D'ANJOU. Principally trained by Francois-Marie Cottin, the entity managed by Remi Cottin will offer 11 two-year-old stores and 23 three-year-olds in training on Wednesday, June 30, together with a further 49 horses-in-training on Thursday, July 1. The second part of the dispersal will take place during the Autumn Sale in November.

Flat-bred Two-Year-Olds: the final Breeze Up of the season

Among the 81 juveniles that will open the sale, several lots are by top established stallions such as EXCEED AND EXCEL, IFRAAJ, KENDARGENT, KODIAK, LOPE DE VEGA, NIGHT OF THUNDER, SEA THE STARS, SIYOUNI etc. as well as from the first crops of young sires such as AL WUKAIR, ATTENDU, PROFITABLE and ZARAK.

Of note:

- **Lot 18**, a half-brother by Exceed And Excel to multiple US Graded winner ELYSEA'S WORLD, from Ecurie Yann Creff;
- **Lot 28**, a half-brother to Group 3 winner PLATANE, hailing from the top Wertheimer family of GOLDIKOVA, also from Ecurie Yann Creff;
- **Lot 37**, a granddaughter by Lope De Vega of Grade 1 winner BUSTER'S READY, from Ecurie Prevost-Baratte.

Two and Three-Year-Old Stores

A selection of two and three-year-old stores from some of France's best jumping families are set to follow on through the ring. The best National Hunt stallions are represented, including AL NAMIX, AUTHORIZED, BLUE BRESIL, BUCK'S BOUM, COKORIKO, DOCTOR DINO, GREAT PRETENDER, KAPGARDE, MASKED MARVEL, MONTMARTRE, NO RISK AT ALL, SAINT DES SAINTS and the late MARTALINE.

Among the well-bred group, there are **6 half-siblings to Group/Grade 1 winners:**

- **Lot 91**, a half-sister to JCB Triumph Hurdle (Gr.1) hero FARCLAS, from Haras des Loges;
- **Lot 98**, a half-brother to QUEL DESTIN, the Future Champions Finale (Gr.1) winner, from Haras des Sablonnets;
- **Lot 129**, a half-brother by Saint des Saints to Prix Renaud du Vivier (Gr.1) scorer MOISES HAS, from Hamel Stud;
- **Lot 131**, a half-sister by Saints des Saints to dual Grade 1 winning chaser FOX NORTON, from Haras des Cordelles;
- **Lot 215**, a half-sister to triple Grade 1 winning hurdler ABACADABRAS, from Haras de la Kammerholtz;
- **Lot 235**, a half-sister to Grade 1 winning chaser DIEGO DU CHARMIL, from Haras de l'Isle Verte.

As well as the well-bred:

- **Lot 92**, a half-brother by Kapgarde to Auteuil Listed winner FOU ET SAGE, from the close family of FEU FOLLET, from RH Bloodstock;
- **Lot 100**, a half-brother by No Risk At All to Grade 3 winners IRJA HAS and IROUFICAR HAS, from Hamel Stud;
- **Lot 126**, a half-sister to triple Grade 2 hurdle and chase winner IRISH SAINT, from Haras du Ma;

- **Lot 128**, a half-brother by Manatee to Group winner ROYALE FRANÇOIS, from the close family of MILORD THOMAS, from Haras du Lieu des Champs.

Haras des Loges will offer 19 lots, including **lot 175**, a son of Doctor Dino out of Prix Cambaceres (Gr.1) winner TANAIIS DU CHENET; **lot 120**, a gelding by Montmartre out of Prix Ingre (Gr.3) scorer MA ROYALE; and **lot 192**, a gelding by No Risk At All out of Prix Bournosienne (Gr.3) winner VIVIANE ROYALE.

Breeding Stock Section

Already the source of top-level winners sold *in utero* since its creation in 2016, the breeding section brings together a stallion, 37 fillies and 93 mares this year.

Of the flat-bred lots:

- **NETTE ROUSSE (lot 338)**, a half-sister to the famous dual Hong Kong Group 1 winner PAKISTAN STAR, from Haras des Cruchettes. She is sold carrying for the first time to Le Havre;
- **THALYIA (lot 348)**, a Listed winner with a current rating of 102, from the excellent family of dual Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner TREVE, from La Motteraye Consignment;
- **SAIGA (lot 356B)**, the Prix Caravelle (L.) winner out of US Grade 1 winner VORDA, consigned by Haras des Cruchettes carrying her first foal by Le Havre.

Over jumps:

- **FAMILIA CRUZ (lot 263)**, a winning daughter of Saint des Saints out of the Listed winner EN LA CRUZ, from Haras du Buff carrying her first foal by Moises Has;
- **GRANDE RAFFLES (lot 346)**, a half-sister by Kapgarde to the excellent FUSIL RAFFLES, also from the family of ALPHA DES OBEAUX, from Haras du Lieu des Champs carrying her first foal by Great Pretender;
- **RAFFLES UTOPIE (lot 353)**, a daughter of Prix Maurice Gillois (Gr.1) winner UTOPIE DES BORDES (lot 353), from the close family of VICTOIRE DES BORDE, from Haras du Lieu des Champs carrying her first foal by Doctor Dino.

Horses-In-Training Section

A further 202 Flat and National Hunt horses-in-training featuring some of the most well-known silks in France will follow on from the breeding section. Top owners such as Wertheimer & Frere and Aga Khan Studs will be represented, as well as trainers including Fabrice Chappet, David Cottin, André Fabre, Christophe Ferland, Francis-Henri Graffard, Freddy Head, Gavin Hernon, Lageneste & Macaire, François Nicolle, Henri-Alex Pantall, François Rohaut, Jean-Claude Rouget etc. feature in this section, that closes the sale. **A further 16 Wild Cards are still to come for recent performers in both disciplines.**

Of note:

- **AL CAPDAMUNT (lot 460)**, a three-year-old gelding by Shalaa, a winner over 1350m following his third placed finish on his debut over 1600m at Saint-Cloud, from Henri-François Devin;
- **GOT BRIGHT (lot 501)**, a half-brother to DABIRSIM, winner of two of his four starts this season with a current rating of 93, from Christophe Ferland;
- **BUZZING (lot 509)**, a three-year-old colt out of SONNERIE, a winner over 1600m twice this season, with a current rating of 89, from Wertheimer & Frere.
- **TAMMANI (lot 512)**, winner of the 2019 Prix Isonomy (L.) and runner-up in the 2020 Prix Daphnis (Gr.3), the four-year-old colt with a current rating of 102 will be offered from Edouard Montfort.

Of the jumpers, David Cottin offers **GREY FALCON (lot 531)**, a four-year-old gelding that won his latest start over hurdles at Auteuil, as well as **HAWAI TREE (lot 540)**, a four-year-old AQPS that finished third in the Prix Hopper (Gr.3) at Compiègne last time. François Nicolle offers the very consistent **CHAPTAL (lot 534)**, a five-year-old gelding that has finished in the first three in two of his three starts this season over hurdles and fences. He was a winner of the Prix General Saint-Didier (Gr.3) as a three-year-old.
